- I. The Perspectives on the Jabez "Hand of God"
 - A. The "Hand of God" intervenes to make <u>PROVISION</u>
 God can provide the needed personal and ministry <u>RESOURCES</u>
 - B. The "Hand of God" intervenes to cause an authority to grant <u>PERMISSION</u> God can make your authority change his mind and grant your <u>REQUEST</u>
 - C. The "Hand of God" intervenes with His <u>PRESENCE</u> God can make His presence known in a specific <u>PLACE</u>
 - D. The "Hand of God" intervenes to defend and <u>TO PROTECT</u>
 God can protect you from any human or spiritual <u>ATTACK</u>
 - E. The "Hand of God" intervenes to overcome limitations with His <u>POWER</u> God is not limited by any of your inadequacies or <u>LIMITATIONS</u>
- II. The Practical Steps for the Jabez "Hand of God"

 HUMBLE yourself under the mighty "Hand of God"
 - ADOPT a lifestyle of proactive dependency upon God
 - NARROW your focus to what God wants done
 - **<u>DEDICATE</u>** yourself to live an ever increasing walk of faith

 - A. You will see the "Hand of God" miraculously <u>INTERVENE</u>
 - B. You will see the "Hand of God" move beyond your **INABILITIES**
 - C. You will see the "Hand of God" overcome the IMPOSSIBLE

- 3 Why did the Lord repeatedly encourage Moses and Joshua that He would be with them? How does the Lord's presence dispel fear? In the great commission, why do you think Jesus reminded the disciples, "I am with you always, even to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:18-20?
- 4 Faith is a muscle that grows stronger or weaker depending on use. List some ways that the Lord stretched your faith in your lifetime.
